Job Summary

Research and fact-checking required to complete the working manuscript of a publication by Phyllis Lambert to be titled How Does Your City Grow.

The book, is a case study based on a series of approximately 150 photographs of Montréal's grey limestone buildings taken by Richard Pare with the author in the early 1970s, presents a study of the growth of cities in North America as seen through existing buildings that result from two overlapping colonial processes. Buildings and the single local material that defines them are surveyed considering where and how they are sited, the actors involved in their realization, and the many factors at the time of their construction that affect their architectural expression and their role in the development of the city.

- Identify and research missing historical information regarding sites, buildings, activities, and occupants
