



Situated within the same site as the Tarsakallak School, The Aupaluk Tridome Community Complex was set out to meet the needs of a larger communal and learning space for the people of Aupaluk.

The tri-dome complex devotes itself to a large gathering space, a creative space, as well as a community greenhouse. The objective is to give the people a garden that yields a variety of nutritious produce using ecological growing techniques, a welcoming community space that provides recreational opportunities and a place to create various art works, or learn about growing and preparing food through structured workshops and individual discoveries.

The reuse of materials is very prominent in the design of the complex. The use of pallets, packaging, sheathing and plastics helps keeps the cost of building low and the structural design allows the three domes to resist high winds and extreme weather conditions.
