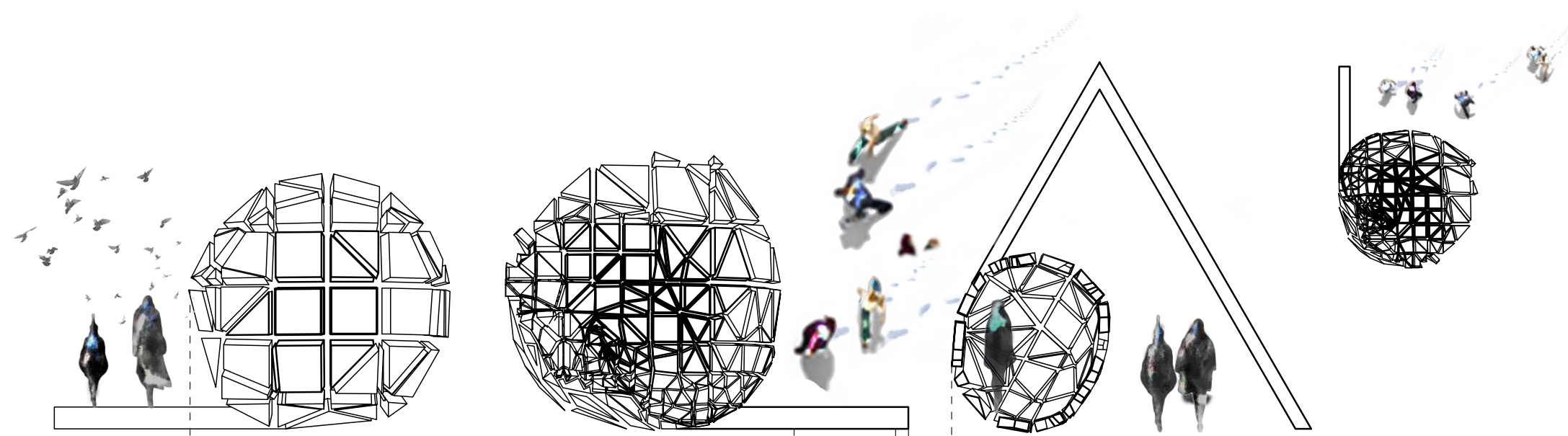

memories of the north

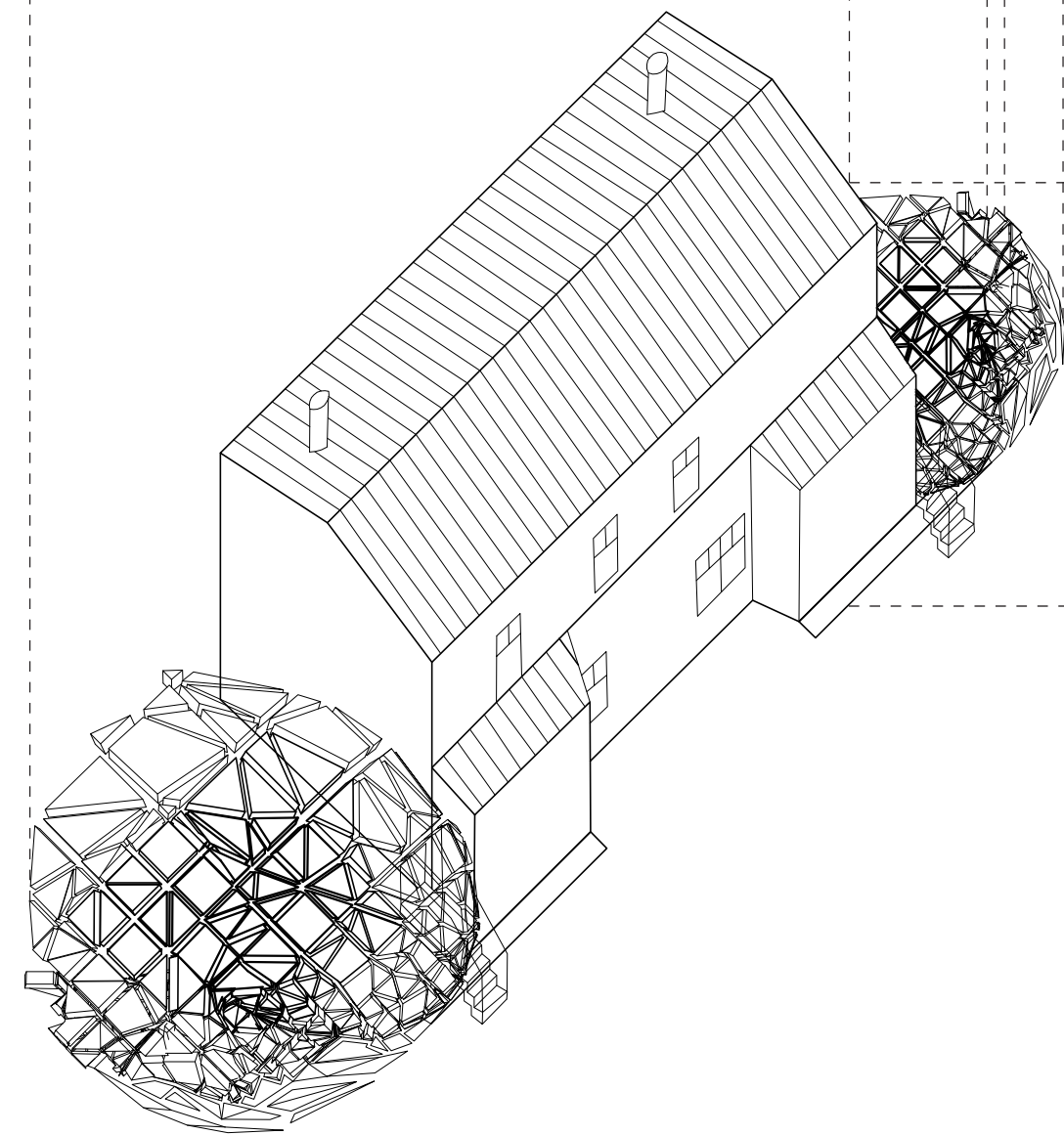




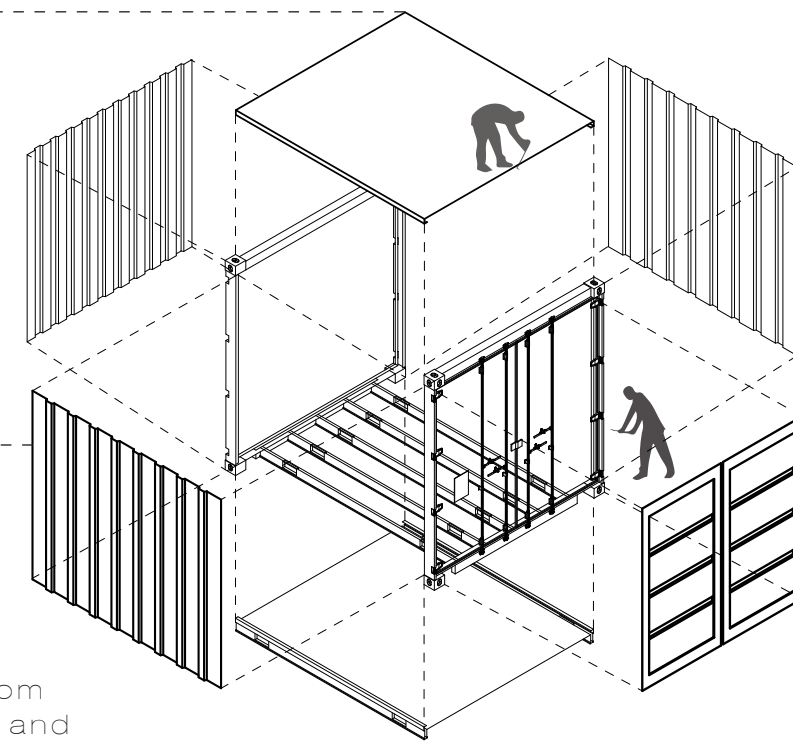
Standing silently upon the frozen earth of the tundra, the peoples of the North forge together to adapt and build living communities. Which resembles a boat, the Umiujaq community offers itself to generate a prototypical outbuilding for the 14 strong of Nunavik.

Through the notion of the circle as community within a square world, prototypical outbuildings were designed to stand together or apart on both land and water. The shelter produces an adaptable framework, allowing the individual to place their imprint upon the ever-changing landscape of the built environment.

Outbuildings
Artifacts salvaged from abandoned materials, and defunct parts



Frame
Scrap metal extrapolated from shipping crates and re-purposed as curvilinear structural frames

Building Components
Water receptacles recycled as insulation, re-purposed plywood and corrugated steel panel cladding, Diesel fuel drums utilized for flotation.
