


Welcome to **THE POD** - a multi-functional, mobile outbuilding with a versatile docking system




Inspired by the ingenuity and resourcefulness of the Inuit, THE POD and docking system is designed to seamlessly integrate the three key elements of the ecosystem of Inuit life in the north: private home, nomadic hunting and fishing, and community togetherness.


Docked at home, THE POD provides additional storage and living space. When hitched to an ATV or automobile, THE POD becomes a home away from home, complete with heating, bedding, and underfoot storage for game or fish. Once returned, THE POD can be docked to the igloo-inspired community centre (built in a hub and spoke design) transforming it into a multi-purpose space where residents can come together and process the catch. This open space promotes sharing, collaboration, community, and the passing on of traditions and customs.

Built from locally-sourced materials, THE POD relies on oil drums and water jugs as basic units of measurement, allowing for uniformity of construction. When filled with water/ice, the transparent plastic water jugs become insulated 4-season building blocks of the light-filled community centre. The oil drums take on new life as community centre storage units, supports for the docking station, and stoves in the mobile POD. Disused tires provide insulation in the cold storage portion of the docking unit.








TOP DOWN view of community center with pod's docked
