This project proposes a better solution to Inuit housing as it does not currently support their lifestyle or match Inuit practices that adjust to the changing seasons

Addressing the problem on an urban and architectural level, this project offers new affordable housing models with detachable units that could be brought to the sea or pulled on land, allowing them to hunt and fish across the territory. This simultaneously promotes their newly found sedentary lifestyle as well as their traditional, hunter-gatherer, nomadic roots

Using materials that can be found in the surrounding area, all housing models are constructed using modular units of standard 20ft shipping containers. Other repurposed materials include insulation, wood from various sources and fuel drums that help keep the detachable unit afloat when used in the water
