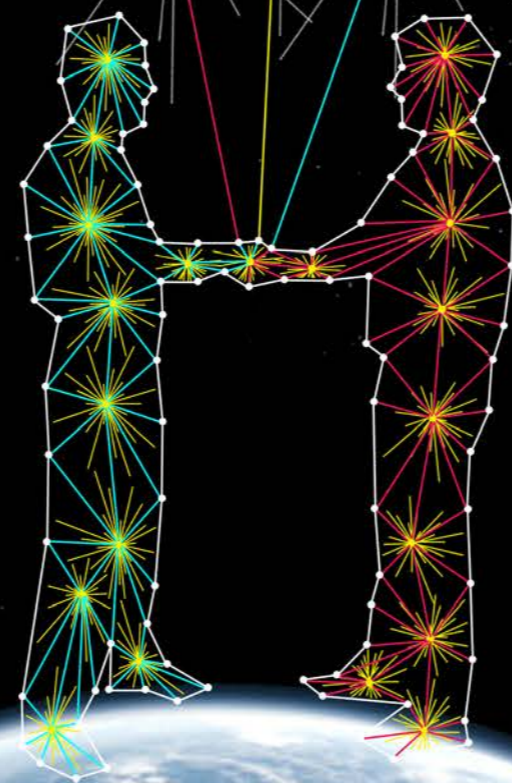
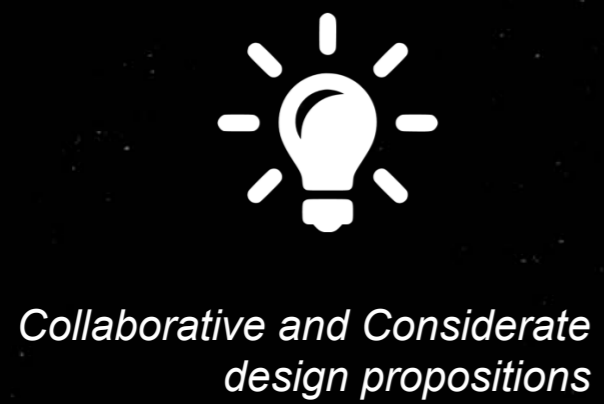


INTER-STELLAR

Upon realizing the proposed intention of this charrette, the team questioned and considered whether or not it was possible to create culturally aware spaces for the people of an entirely different culture, given there is no direct connection between the team and its proposed demographic. Canada is a culturally diverse country. Confines on the Inuit culture have modified the Nomadic lifestyle that was once prevalent; disconnecting them from the neighbouring regions and communities. They exist in a region that is currently being affected by climate change, leaving few available resources of which the Nunavik peoples can live off of. This leads to irregular methods of living, reinforcing the idea of scarcity in the minds of onlookers in neighbouring regions. These methods are what the future requires, reassembling materials and space to suit ones needs rather than consuming and transporting new resources. Inter-Stellar hopes to address presumptions about Nunavik's people and their inspiring efforts to live off of what the immediate environment provides, empower the youth of both regions, and teach Canadian communities how to "hack themselves" so that legitimate changes can be made now through learning and in the future through application.

Inter-Stellar is motivated to create permanent connections and partnerships that would allow for the proper development of Nunavik's communities while reconnecting people through respective collaborations. This created community would allow for the exchange of knowledge regarding culture, genuine concerns about climate change, methods of adaptation and solutions. Lessons from both elders and professors at each stop of the journey ensures that both parties connect with considerate amounts of new knowledge. Inter-Stellar allows for youth and their elders from the Nunavik communities to engage in a Nomadic journey between the partaking Universities, staying with their host families, while students and professors in the vicinity of Universities would embark on their own Nomadic journey through the communities of Nunavik. This exchange creates a greater sense of pride in one's own cultural roots while instilling the notion that we are all connected in our lives.
