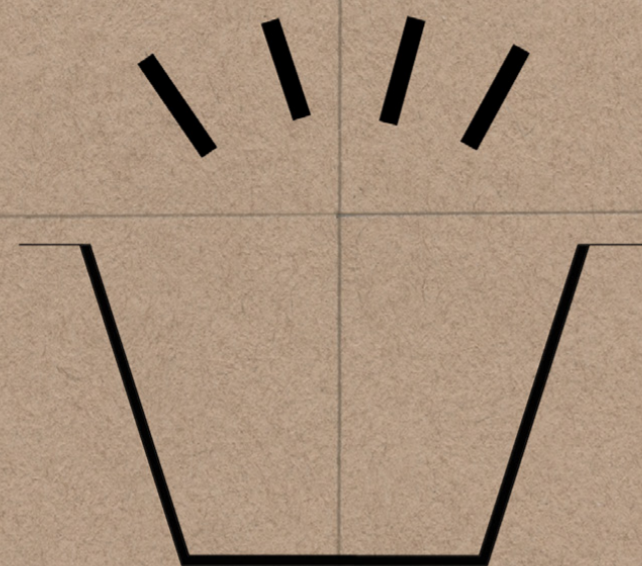


Fin de partie: Solidarity CATscan is an alternative future in which protests are a service provided under the jurisdiction of the military. Using an online platform, citizens vote on an ongoing basis to determine the location of a single mobile protest well assigned to the city. At any moment online votes may change and when another place has more votes the protest well gets relocated immediately.

The protest well is a cone shaped structure that is leveled with the ground. Participants enter the area via concrete ramps that are accessible to all. Once in the bottom of the well, participants enter onto a civic arena with a wooden scaffold on which are propped an armature of copper wiring dipped in milk paint. At the center of the structure are positioned a fixed number of turquoise-cushioned military stretchers.

The protest well can only be activated when all available beds are occupied. Through a weighted lever attached to each headrest, a magnet triggers the audio-outlet mechanism. A noise is emitted continuously to the surrounding environment.
